For the kids from Austinmer Public, a highlight was winning an original *Tashi* illustration, which Kim Gamble drew on the stage during the ceremony. Other winning schools were Orana Heights PS who received a box of books worth \$300; and St Joseph's Kilaben Bay who took home a set of KOALA Syba Signs for their library. All students attending the awards received a book thanks to the generosity of publishers.

To empower kids to have their say about their favourite books for 21 continuous years was an amazing milestone for KOALA. There are now four book categories catering to junior and senior reading tastes. In 2002 we took the first steps towards creating a National Children's Choice Awards by joining with Victoria to produce a common shortlist. This year we hope to see NT, SA and Tasmania join us in creating a truly national Children's Choice Book Award. By passing on our enthusiasm for reading to students, this dream can become a reality.

Through the generosity of past KOALA president, Miranda Harrowell, who initiated a fund to assist students from a NSW regional school to participate in KOALA, we are organising Deb Abela — popular author of the Max Remy series — to visit Armidale & chat to kids about their favourite books. It is difficult for many regional schools to attend the KOALA awards, so this year we are sending a little bit of KOALA into the country!

Once again, we have raised enough money to sponsor two 'real' koalas at Taronga Zoo and students at Lucas Heights Community School have offered to be 'foster parents' for one koala. If your school would like to foster the other koala, please email me and we will send out information to your school.

Once again, I look forward to working with you to encourage reading for pleasure and promoting Australian books and authors to all our students.

NOMINATE & WIN!

Why Nominate? The nomination process in first term is vital to KOALA's success. Any Australian book first published in the last ten years (i.e. 1998 – 2007) is eligible. It cannot be a previous KOALA winner. The books your students nominate as their favourites are collated with those from other schools & libraries. The ten most popular books in each category make up the shortlist. Please encourage your students to nominate as many of their favourite Aussie books as possible.

Series such as *Boyz Rule!* where the main characters are different should be nominated as a series but books with a common character such as Rascal the dragon, Selby or Old Tom should be nominated as individual titles. If you are uncertain, just send in your nomination as an individual title or email us anytime with your queries.

Schools that send their nominations by the 14th March go into the draw to win a set of books. We have a set of eight *Too Cool* books for a primary school and a set of 2 books by Matthew Reilly for a lucky secondary school. So start reading and get your nominations in by the deadline date.
